There shall be eight (8) additional entries (floaters).

1. To be eligible to receive additional entry(ies) to the State Debate Tournament, a League must average two (2) wins per entry or better.
2. The eight floating entries are to be distributed:
 - a. One to each eligible League
 - b. Any remaining entry(ies) are to be distributed to the Leagues with the greatest average wins per entry.
3. Tie-breaker: In the event of ties between Leagues, the tie shall be broken on the basis of greater average wins per entry in the four previous State Tournaments. If a tie still exists, the tie shall be broken on the basis of average wins per entry five years prior, six years prior, etc.
